Annual Community Survey Results Review of annual survey results. Riders and Non-riders stated they would like to receive information about Benzie Bus via Facebook, our website, or a phone app. Drivers and Dispatchers once again scored in the 90th percentile for customer service. Overall, Riders and Non-Riders are very happy with what we do.

Non-Emergency Medical Transportation - We're having 1000 postcards printed and mailed. DHHS has the mailing labels, Benzie Chamber is letting us use their permit number for postage. Rides through Medical Transportation Management totaled 18 for May, with no advertising. We feel optimistic that NEMT numbers will continue to improve.

Job Access and Reverse Commute - TC 22 Times & Airport Connections BATA and Benzie Bus will be doing some joint outreach events the second week of August to promote commuter services. We'll be at Interlochen and Lake Ann with buses, free food, and are seeing if we can get a radio station to do a Live Broadcast. Bill and Jessica met with Munson and are working on designing a commuter program with them. In September Munson is breaking ground on a new parking structure. We'll be doing an outreach event the third week of August at Munson and will be giving Munson employees free rides to work during the month of September.

New Shelters: Frankfort 2nd St; Thompsonville Library; Honor Public Parking Lot Bill and Jessica are working on the design of the shelter posters

Regional Connections Cadillac - Grand Rapids via Indian Trails Jessica and Bill are working with Cadillac on improving connections for Indian Trails.
