Please remember to cancel any scheduled trips that are no longer needed. Enforcement of Benzie Bus's Cancellation Policy is suspended at this time.

Please also be prepared that as the coronavirus situation evolves that Benzie Bus may need to make additional service adjustments as needed.

**Benzie Bus Health and Safety Efforts Continue:**

- Please know that if you need transportation, Benzie Bus is safe and clean.
- Increased vehicle and facility cleanings and disinfection activities continue.
- Starting this week all passenger seats directly behind the driver of the vehicle will be folded up in order for that seat be left open whenever possible to try and maintain distance between passengers and staff.

**Riders Please Remember the Following:**

- Wash your hands often. If soap and water is not available, use hand sanitizer.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene by covering your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or use a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
